Why are membership rates increasing?

YMCA of the Rockies hasn't increased membership rates since 2016, yet operation costs have increased, especially in our mountain regions of Estes Park and Granby, Colorado. The fee adjustment allows YMCA of the Rockies to continue offering facilities, staff, programs and services included with membership. We greatly appreciate your understanding as we strive to continue to offer exceptional service.

When do the increases start?

December 1, 2023
