



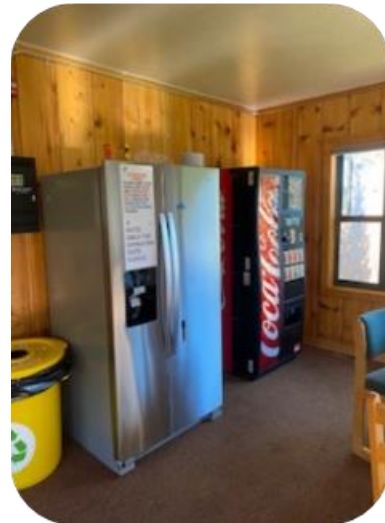

YMCA of the Rockies Drug & Alcohol Policy

YMCA of the Rockies is committed to safe, healthy, wholesome, and productive working and living environments for its staff, volunteers, and guests. In order to help promote these values, YMCA of the Rockies prohibits employees and volunteers from engaging in the use, sale, distribution, manufacture, cultivation, or possession of drugs, drug containers, paraphernalia, derivatives, or controlled substances. Any use of illegal drugs or controlled substances (including marijuana) by any employee or volunteer of YMCA of the Rockies, regardless of the location or circumstances, will not be tolerated.

YMCA of the Rockies also prohibits employees and volunteers from the use, sale, distribution, or possession of any alcohol while on YMCA of the Rockies property. This policy is effective in all areas of staff housing including bedrooms and lobbies, Camp Chief Ouray (CCO) overnight camp facilities, and all other YMCA buildings and grounds.

As interpreted by management, violations of housing policies and inappropriate behavior will not be tolerated. As a representative of the YMCA of the Rockies, staff and volunteers must maintain appropriate behavior at all times, even when they are not working, and should not appear impaired at any time.

Pets

No pets of any kind are allowed. If you have a registered Emotional Support or Service animal, please contact cforst@ymcarockies.org to obtain the required documents needing completion by your physician. These documents must be received and approved before you arrive on the property with your emotional support or service animal.

Cooking

No cooking appliances will be allowed in rooms. Cooking appliances include but are not limited to hot plates, electric fryers, crock pots, coffee machines, electric kettles, microwaves, toaster ovens, etc. Staff housing common areas will have a refrigerator, microwave, and Keurig
